

AWARDS AND CERTIFICATES

CATEGORIES OF AWARDS :

1. Winner of the Final Round will be given the **“Best Team”** Trophy and cash prize of **Rs. 5100/-**
2. Runner-up of the Final Round will be given the **“Runner up”** Trophy and cash prize of **Rs. 3100/-**
3. Team with the highest memorial scores will be given the **“Best Memorial”** a cash prize worth **Rs.1100/-**
4. **“Best Mooter”** award shall be determined on the basis of the total marks secured during the court rounds and a cash prize of **Rs.1100/-**
5. **“Best Researcher”** Award shall be determined on the basis of Researcher Test and a cash prize of **Rs.1100/-**

*Certificates will be provided to the team with the **Second Best Memorial, Second Best Speaker and Second Best Researcher**. In addition to the above, a Certificate of Participation and memento will be awarded to all the participants.*

RULES FOR MOOT COURT

- ❖ Students of 3 year and 5 year law degree courses from any University are eligible to apply for registration of their team.
- ❖ Each team shall consist only of three members, comprising of two speakers and one researcher.
- ❖ Participating teams should register themselves by sending duly filled registration form along with registration fee **Rs. 1000/-** per team and memorials by email to **idealmootcourt1@gmail.com** and by post to Ideal Institute of Management and Technology & School of Law, 16-X, Karkardooma Institutional Area, Delhi-110092 before **18th March, 2016**. Acknowledgment of the same shall be sent by the Moot Court Committee till **21st March 2016**.
- ❖ Teams have to prepare memorials for both the sides and have to submit **8** hard copies and one soft copy according to the rules mentioned in the Rules and Regulations.
- ❖ The competition shall be held in English language.
- ❖ The result announced by the judges shall be final and binding.
- ❖ There will be penalties for the violations of the rules.
- ❖ The Organizing Committee shall have sole discretion to assess penalties or to disqualify teams for failure to abide by any of the foregoing Rules.
- ❖ A Researcher Test shall also be conducted for adjudicating the “Best Researcher”.
