The first and second questions carry 40 marks each and the motivation letter carries 20 marks. All the three components must be answered in order for the organizers to evaluate the team. The front page should have the following information of all the participants: Name, Contact Number, Email Address and Name of Institution.

- Write a brief note on the vulnerability of Refugee children to human trafficking in the context of India. What are the steps that need to be taken to protect them from such exploitation? (1000 words exclusive offootnotes)
 - Use both International and national legal instruments to substantiate your answer. You can also rely on the approaches adopted by other South Asian countries.
- Write a brief note on any ongoing armed conflicts in India and whether such a conflict can be identified as a Non-International Armed conflict. (1000 words exclusive of footnotes)
 Use both International and national legal instruments to substantiate your answer.
- 3. A Letter of Motivation stating the reasons for the interest in International Humanitarian Law and Child Rights and this particular Competition (500 words)

The First two questions shall have the following marking criteria:

- 1. Knowledge of Law and Facts 8 marks for each question
- 2. Clarity, Brevity and Style 8 marks for each question
- 3. Use of Authorities and Citation (Any uniform citation style will be accepted) 4 marks for each question
- 4. Analysis and Organisation 16 marks for each question
- 5. General Impression 4 marks for each question
