Union of India and Others* J.Radakrishnan, after referring to catena of judgments of certain International Covenants, opined that gender identity is one of the most fundamental aspects of life which refers to a person's intrinsic sense of being male, female, or transgender or transsexual person. Judgments, albeit represent the nation, cannot change the thoughts of the society.
