The Competition will be conducted and managed by the Centre for Research and Innovation of Geeta Institute of Law, Panipat and will be held in ONILINE MODE. Interested participants can register themselves by filling the online Google form after paying the registration fees (As the payment receipt has to be attached in Google Form). The registrations are already open. We look forward to your participation in 'International Legal Article Writing Competition 2020'.

THEME OF THE COMPETITION

The theme of the competition is "World's Recent Developments In Human Rights" and participants are free to choose any of the following Sub-Themes:

- Decreasing Rate of Literacy v. Right to Education
- World's Refugee Crisis vis-à-vis Right to Self Determination
- Freedom of Speech & Expression v. Political Power: A World Scenario

- Increasing Crime Against Women
- Human Trafficking Around the Globe
- Violation of Child Rights
- Rights of Vulnerable Groups

The above list of sub-themes is not exhaustive and other contemporary issues in World's Human Rights can also be opted to write upon.

Competition Rules:

- 1. *Eligibility:* Students (i.e. under and post graduate), research scholars, legal professionals and others interested in social sciences are eligible to participate.
- 2. Co-authorship of one is allowed.
- 3. Article should be the original work of the participants and must not exceed 6,000 words (including footnotes). The language of the articles should be English. Any kind of plagiarism will result in immediate disqualification. Bluebook 19th edition should be adhered to for the purpose of citations.
- 4. The submission should only in "doc. or docx." format.
- 5. Submission should strictly follow the following rules:

 Font Time New Roman, Font size- 12, Line spacing- 1.5, Alighment-Justified
- 6. E-Certificates will be provided to all participants.
