6. The essays should be typed in Times New Roman, Font Size-12, Line Spacing-1.5, and Justified.

7. The footnotes must be typed in Times New Roman, Font Size-10 and Line Spacing-1.

8. The margins should be 1" or 2.54 cm on all sides.

9. Every citation must follow the Harvard Bluebook, 20th Edition.

10. Co-authorship up to 2 authors is permitted.
