SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Abstract: The abstract should not exceed 300 words and must be accompanied by a cover page stating the following:-

- Title of the Paper
- Name of the author(s)
- E-mail address
- Postal address and
- Contact Number

Full Research Paper:

- The paper should not exceed 5000 words (exclusive of footnotes)
- Co-authorship is permitted with a maximum of two authors only.
- In case of co-authorship at least one author must attend the seminar to present the paper.
- In case a student is presenting the paper of a faculty member, the same shall be allowed only if the student has co-authored the paper.
- The main text should be in Times New Roman with font size 12 and spacing of 1.5. The footnotes should be in Times New Roman, font size 10 with single spacing.
- One inch margins on all sides should be maintained.
- Citation style: Blue Book, 19th Edition or ILI Citation style
- The paper must be accompanied with the scanned copies of the filled in Registration form, DD details, and the cover page, the details of which are mentioned in the abstract guidelines.
- All submissions must be the author's original and unpublished work.
- Plagiarized submissions will be disqualified.

Method of Submission :

Interested participants have to make a *provisional* registration through mail at the mentioned Email address editorialboard.chief@gmail.com till 17th March, 2020.
