Who can participate?

We look forward to participation from UG & PG students studying in any discipline at any Colleges / any Departments of the Universities.

What is the format of the quiz?

The entire quiz would be timed. Each question is to be answered within a minimum of **10 seconds** (**timings for each question shall be specified right above it**). The Quiz shall be comprising of 70 Questions (**1 Mark each**) and would be a mix of multiple-choice, true/false statement, specific-answer question, pictorial/audio-visual questions etc. accessible via online mode only.

What will the Quiz cover?

The quiz will focus on the Constitution of India and cover questions ranging from its history, current affairs to interpretative questions.

What are the rules and regulations governing the quiz?

- The National Level quiz shall be based on Individual participation only. Registration is mandatory for the Quiz. No team registrations entertained.
- Replacement of any participant is not allowed post registration.
- If at the time of logging in to the platform the participant faces any technical glitch, the organizers shall not be responsible for the same. Complaints relating network issues shall not be entertained.
- Participants are advised to be online with decent internet connectivity at least 30 minutes before the Quiz begins.
- Certificate of Participation shall be given to all the Registered participants who actually take part by logging in at the time of the Quiz and Certificates will be sent on the e-mail id mentioned in the google registration form link.

- All the certificates which will be issued to the participants shall be in the form of "E-certificates".
- In case of any ambiguity, the decision of the Organizers shall be final and binding.
- The Participants are advised to check their Email-ids and WhatsApp regularly for updates.
- Participants will be allowed to give themselves an appropriate CODE name which shall be their unique identity related to the competition, subject to the final decision of the core committee.
- No Negative Marking.
- Multiple submissions from the same participant shall stand rejected.
- In case of a Tie, individual having taken the least time to respond would win.
- The link and game code of the timed quiz will be open for participation on Quizizz, only on 6th May 2020 and will be mailed to each of the participants prior hand.
- Names of the Winners shall be put up on the college website as well as intimated personally via e-mails.

- Students must send scanned copy of either their college ID card (preferred) or a letter of participation (Word document containing "Name of the participant, Course, Year/Semester, Institution details, Contact No.", "email id" with a declaration of the details being bonafide) over the Google registration form link.
- Candidates are required to submit all necessary information over the Google registration form link failing which registration shall stand cancelled.
- Any number of individuals may participate from the same institution.
