Adv. Gautam Bhatia completed his BCL and MPhil at **Oxford** (2011 – 2013) as a **Rhodes Scholar**, and LLM at the **Yale Law School** (2014). He is also an acclaimed author, with 3 books to his credit, *Offend, Shock, or Disturb: Freedom of Speech under the Indian Constitution* (OUP 2015); *The Transformative Constitution* (HarperCollins India 2019) and his recently published, first sci-fi novel, *The Wall*. He is the editor of the award-winning *Strange Horizons* magazine. Moreover, he practiced for four years as a lawyer in New Delhi, and was part of the legal teams challenging the constitutionality of Section 377 of the Indian Penal Code and the Aadhaar project. His work has been cited by the Supreme Court of India, and by various High Courts.
