RULES AND REGULATIONS

Symbiosis Law School, Hyderabad

NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, Symbiosis Law School, Hyderabad, constituent of the Symbiosis International (Deemed University) has announced its **1st Symbiosis Law School, Hyderabad, National Corporate Restructuring Competition – 2019**, to be held from 17th August 2019 & 18 August 2019 to enable students from all across India to participate to showcase their majesty over corporate restructuring strategies ;

THEREFORE, the Centre for Corporate and Competition Law of Symbiosis Law School, Hyderabad, hereby makes the following rules, namely:-

I. ELIGIBILITY

- 1.1. Students duly enrolled and pursuing full time 5 years or 3 years law course from any recognized institute.
- 1.3 A maximum of one team shall be allowed to participate from an Institution.

II. TEAM COMPOSITION

- 2.1 A team may consist of maximum three members
- 2.2 A team may consist of 3 members that shall include two speakers and one draftsman.
- 2.3 Any person, other than the three registered team members is not eligible to avail facilities reserved for the participants.

III. REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

- 3.1 The team shall register by submission of a duly filled form in the prescribed manner (**Refer Annexure-I**) on or before declared date.
- 3.2 The registration form is required to be submitted online on or before the declared date to cccl@slsh.edu.in
- 3.3 Registration after the given deadline shall not be accepted, under any circumstances.
- 3.4 On receipt of the duly filled registration form, the institute shall respond to the participating team, acknowledging the receipt.
- 3.5 On receipt of the registration form in the prescribed manner a unique team identification code shall be allotted.
- 3.6 The participation of a team is deemed to be confirmed on receipt of the registration form and allotment of a unique team identification code.

IV. REGISTRATION FEE

The Registration fee for the competition is INR 3,500 (In words – Rupees Three Thousand Five Hundred Only) inclusive of GST @ 18% which includes accommodation and food for the competition days, library access, Wi – Fi and any other facilities provided by the institute to its discretion.

V. PAYMENT OF REGISTRATION FEE

- 5.1 The registration fee is to be paid through a wire transfer only.

5.2 The required details for the same are contained in Annexure III.

5.3 Any additional charges incurred by the team while making the wire transfer are to be borne by them.

5.4 All teams must email a scanned copy of the receipt generated on completion of the wire transfer at cccl@slsh.edu.in

VI. CLARIFICATIONS

6.1 Clarifications can be sought on any part of the case vehicle and must be clear. These clarifications are to be send via e-mail at cccl@slsh.edu.in

6.2 The clarification e-mails are to be send on or before the declared date.

VII. ANONYMITY OF TEAMS

7.1 Teams shall not reveal their identity in any form during the Competition, except by the means of their Team Code allotted

7.2 Teams must not reveal the name of their institution or names of the participants, anywhere in the written submissions or in the course of the oral arguments. Teams must also not make use of or display in any manner whatsoever any logo, pins, badges etc. that indicates the Institution represented by them.

7.3 Any violation of Rules 7.1 & 7.2 shall attract severe penalty or disqualification as determined by the Governing Council. The decision of the Governing Council in this regard shall be final and binding; not subject to challenge.

7.4 While submitting the written submission, the e-mail should have no reference to the name of the institution and should only contain the team code.

VIII. WRITTEN SUBMISSIONS

8.1 Each team shall submit 2 sets of written submissions & carry 3 sets of written submissions with them. The top right corner of the cover page of the written submissions shall mention the allotted team code.

8.2 The comprehensive arguments with appropriate citations shall be contained in the Submission. The teams shall follow The Bluebook: A Uniform form of citation (20th Ed.).

8.3 A soft copy shall be emailed to cccl@slsh.edu.in in PDF format on the declared date.

8.4 Plagiarized written submissions or any part thereof shall serve as a ground for disqualification at any stage of the competition.

8.5 **FORMAT:-** The written submissions shall contain all of and only the following heads namely –

8.5.1 Cover Page

8.5.2 Table of Contents

8.5.3 Index of Authorities

8.5.4 Submissions (In points 1, 2, 3...)

8.6 **FONT AND SPACING:-**

8.6.1 All written submissions shall be typed on one side of standard A4 size paper

8.6.2 The font and size of the text used in all parts of the written submissions (except the covers) shall be in font size 12 in Times New Roman and footnotes shall be in font size 10 in Times New Roman.

8.6.3 The font and size of the text used in all parts of the written submissions (except the covers) shall be in font size 12 in Times New Roman and footnotes shall be in font size 10 in Times New Roman.

8.6.4 The text in all parts of each written submission shall have 1.5 lines spacing except the text of footnotes and headings which shall be single spaced. , with margins of one inch (1.5 cms) on all sides.

IX. SUBMISSION OF SOFT COPIES

9.1 Each registered team shall submit the a soft copy of the Written Submission to the Governing council on or before the declared date via e-mail to cccl@slsh.edu.in before 5:00 PM.

9.2 The name of the file shall be the Team Code allotted to the respective teams.

9.3 The subject of the submission should be **TEAMCODE-Submission**

9.4 Submission made after the specified deadline shall lead to penalties in the form of deductions from the marks. **Every one hours lapse would attract a deduction of 1 mark.**

X. ASSESSMENT OF WRITTEN SUBMISSION

10.1 All the submission shall be assessed out of 100 marks.

10.2 The assessment shall be according to the predetermined parameters:-

10.2.1 Clarity of thought(20 Marks)

10.2.2 Use of Restructuring Techniques (20 Marks)

10.2.3 Presentation (20 Marks)

10.2.4 Originality (10 Marks)

10.2.5 Use of case studies (10 Marks)

XI. SUBMISSION OF HARCOPIES

11.1 The written submission that the teams carry along with them should be submitted to the governing council during the registration on the day of the competition.

11.2 The soft copy submitted to the governing council should be identical with the hard copies any discrepancies in this regard would lead to disqualification of the team.

XII. DRESS CODE

12.1 The participants shall adhere to the following dress code while in the Board Room.

12.1.1 **Ladies**- Indian Formals (Kurta or Salwar) OR Western Formal (Formal Shirt and Black Pant/Skirt) with Shoe and Blazer.

12.1.2 **Gentlemen**- Formal Shirt, Black Trousers, Tie, Blazer and Shoe.

12.2 The above mentioned dress code extends to Inauguration and Valedictory also.

XIII. STRUCTURE OF THE COMPETITION

13.1 The competition will be conducted for two days on 17th and 18th August 2019. The preliminary rounds and the quarter finals shall be conducted on 17th August 2019, followed by semi- finals and Finals on 18th August 2019.

13.2 PRELIMINARY ROUNDS:-

13.2.1 The first round of the competition would be the preliminary round in which each team would be given an opportunity to present the Restructuring method provided by them before the expert panel of the judges

13.2.2 Each team will get **20 Minutes** for the presentation (Inclusive of the time for the questions from the judges). Extension of time shall be the discretion of the judges.

13.2.3 Preliminary round shall be decided on the basis of allocation of a total of 100 marks; which includes 30 percent of the marks of written submission and 70 percent of the marks of oral rounds.

13.2.4 First two teams of each Board Room will qualify for the quarter finals. In case of any tie the decision will be based on the Score of the written submission.

13.3 QUARTER FINALS:-

13.3.1 In the quarter finals the bottom four shall draw the lots to decide the opponents and the opponents would be the top four teams.

13.3.2 The teams shall exchange their written submission before this round during the draw of lots.

13.3.3 Each team will get 20 min of speaking time to present their Draft.

13.3.4 In this round the teams will get an additional 5 min to speak on the lapses in the suggestions provided by the opponents.

13.3.5 This round shall be a knock out round.

13.3.6 Extension of time shall be the discretion of the judges.

13.3.7 The winner is declared solely on the basis of their oral presentation in this round.

13.3.8 Winning four teams will qualify for the Semi Finals.

13.4 SEMI FINALS:-

13.4.1 Each team will get 30 min of speaking time to present their Draft.

13.4.2 In this round the teams will get an additional 5 min to speak on the lapses in the suggestions provided by the opponents.

13.4.3 Other governing standards as mentioned under rules 13.3 shall apply.

13.5 FINALS:-

13.5.1 The top teams from each board room shall qualify for the Finals.

13.5.2 Each team will get 30 min of speaking time to present their Draft.

13.5.3 In this round the teams will get an additional 5 min to speak on the lapses in the suggestions provided by the opponents.

13.5.4 Other governing standards as mentioned under rules 13.3 shall apply.

XIV. ASSESSMENT CRITERIA FOR ORAL PRESENTATIONS.

14.1 The performance of the orators shall be judged on the following criteria out of 100 Marks in total in all rounds.

14.1.1 Knowledge of the facts (20 Marks)

14.1.2 Application of the Restructuring and Business Knowledge (20 Marks)

14.1.3 Presentation Skill (20 Marks)

14.1.4 Clarity in Thoughts (10 Marks)

14.1.5 Response to Questions (10 Marks)

14.1.6 Professional Appearance (10 Marks)

14.1.7 Critical Analysis (10 Marks)

XV. SCOUTING

15.1 The teams shall be strictly prohibited from witnessing any other teams presentation in which they are not participants. The violation of the same may lead to strict action by the Governing Council.

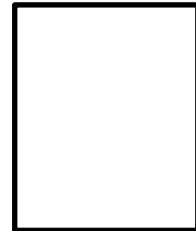

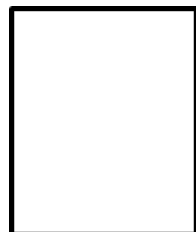

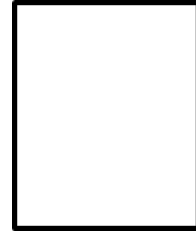
